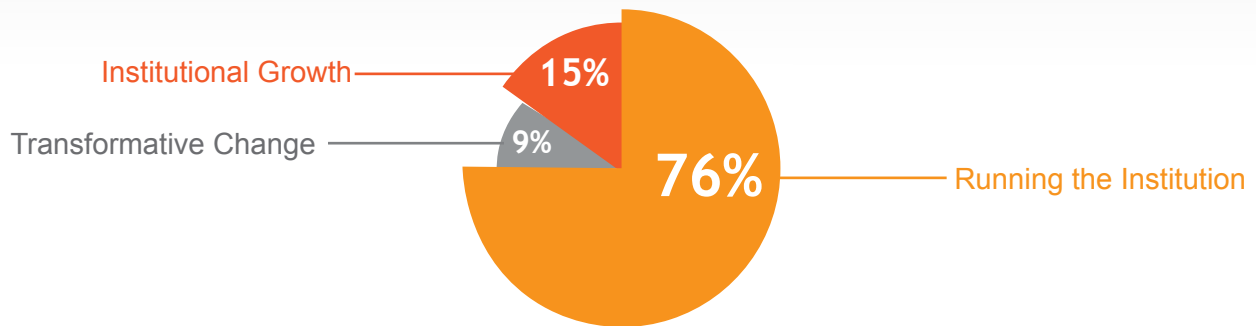


Sustainable IT Funding Models

By ensuring IT funding models have long-term support, institutions avoid the chaos of a reactive IT strategy. Many schools are getting ahead of technology management with a

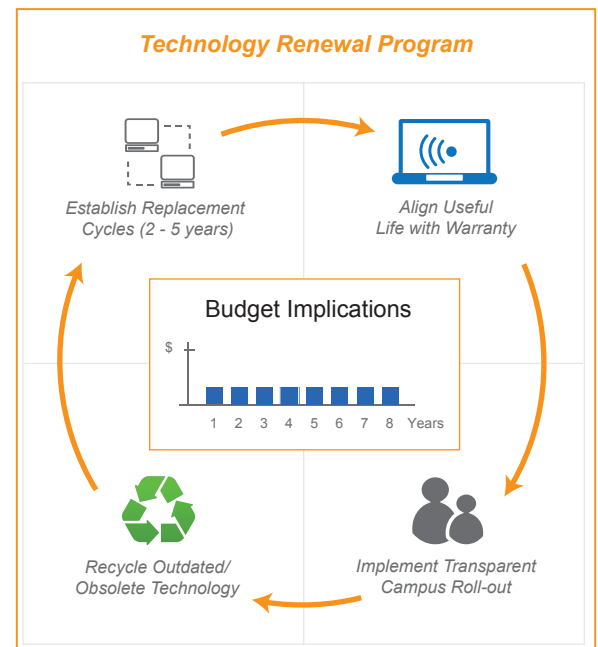
